Research Traditions

- a systematic process of inquiry consisting of three elements or components:
 - a question, problem, or hypothesis (Dick Allwright talks about 'a puzzle')
 - data
 - analysis and interpretation of data.

Research Traditions

Quantitative – natural sciences to study natural phenomena (labs). External truths which can be proved or disproved.

Qualitative – the complexity of social interactions in daily life and the meanings that participants give to these.

Research Traditions

Different approaches can complement and supplement each other.
